

# 4 Row Ski & Rod Holder

### Caution

- Tie down long or wide loads at the front and rear of the vehicle with non-elastic straps. If it looks like it can catch some air, it will. TIE IT DOWN!
- Check straps periodically during travel and tighten if necessary. Replace any straps that are worn or frayed before using (see your Prorack dealer).

#### Important Warning

- It is critical that all Prorack racks and accessories be properly and securely attached to your vehicle. Improper attachment could result in an automobile accident, and could cause serious bodily injury or death to you or to others.
- You are responsible for securing the racks and accessories to your car, checking the attachments prior to use, and periodically inspecting the products for adjustment, wear, and damage. Therefore, you must read and understand all of the instructions and cautions supplied with your Prorack product prior to installation or use.
- If you do not understand all of the instructions and cautions, or if you have no mechanical experience and are not thoroughly familiar with the installation procedures, you should have the product installed by a professional installer such as a roof rack specialist.

### Safety Checks

- Before Driving Away:
  - Ensure all hardware is secured according to instructions.
  - Test movement by rocking holders.
  - Tighten again if loose.
  - Attachment hardware can loosen over time:
  - Check straps periodically during travel and tighten if necessary.
- Replace any straps that are worn or frayed before using (see your Prorack dealer).
- · Some longer loads may prevent the rear hatch from fully opening.
  - Always use caution when opening your hatch.

### Care and Maintenance

• Use non-water soluble lubricant on screws. Use a soft cloth with water and mild detergent to clean plastic parts.
